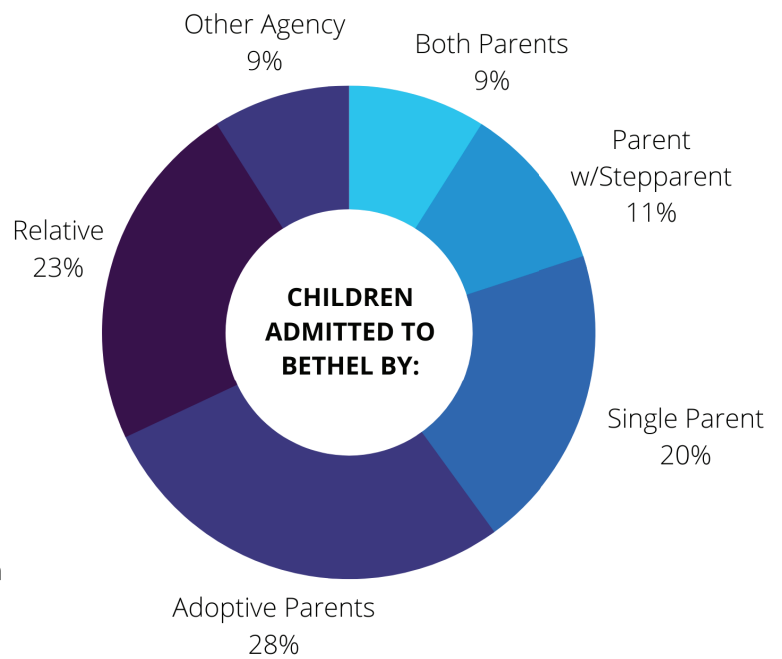
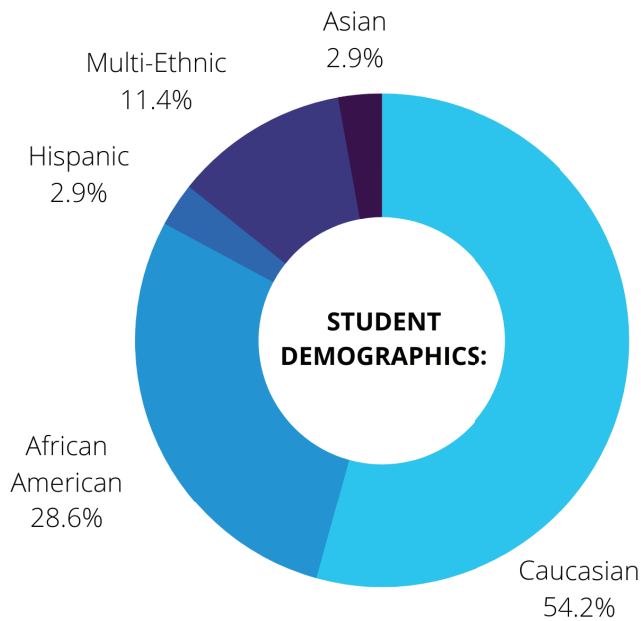

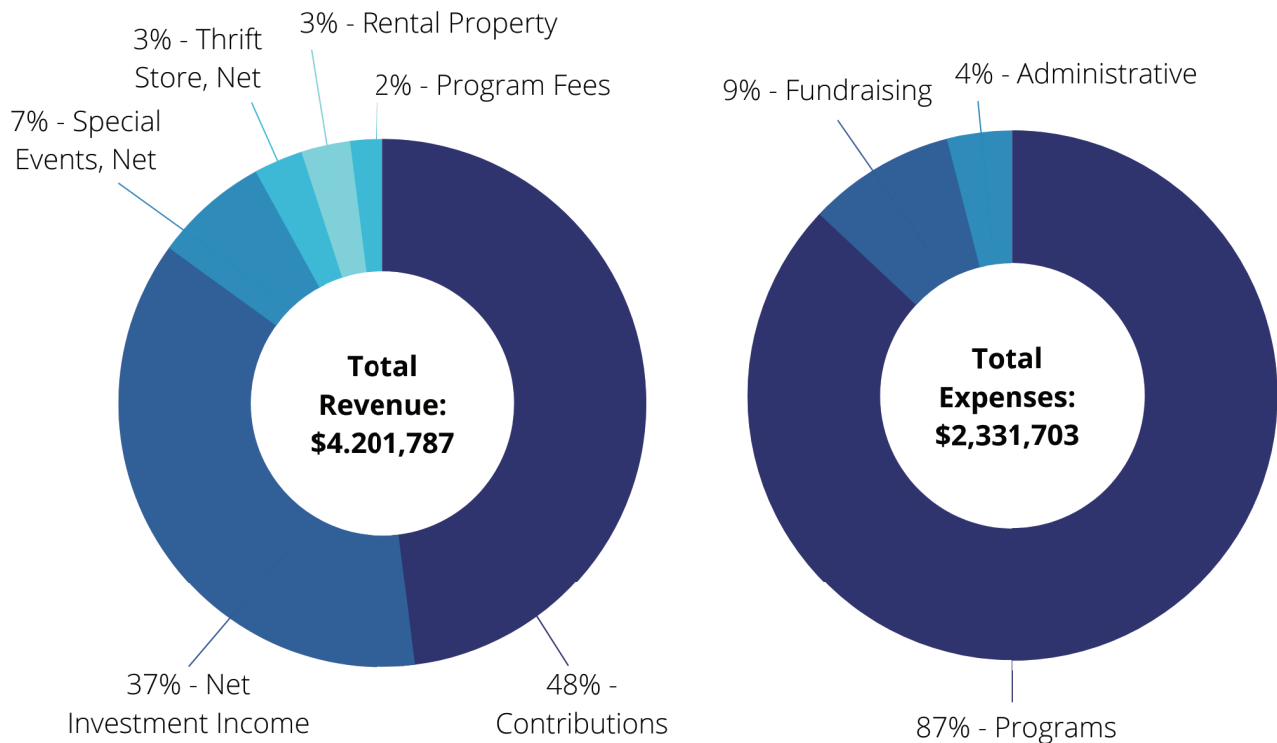

Bethel is committed to strong financial stewardship and using your donations wisely.



87¢ of every dollar went directly to programs helping children facing adversity.

Special event revenues are included in revenue net of direct expenses of \$62,578. Numbers are based on unaudited financial information for fiscal year ending March 31, 2022. Additional financial information and accounting policies may be reviewed in our annual independently audited financial statements which expressed a clean opinion for the year ended March 31, 2021.

Approximately **75%** of all food costs were offset by in-kind donations & food drives.
