

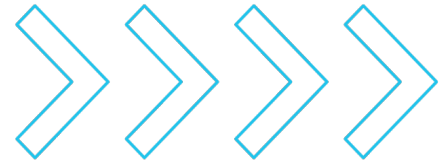

Thank you for staying the course with us, praying for us, and blessing us with your time, talent and treasure!

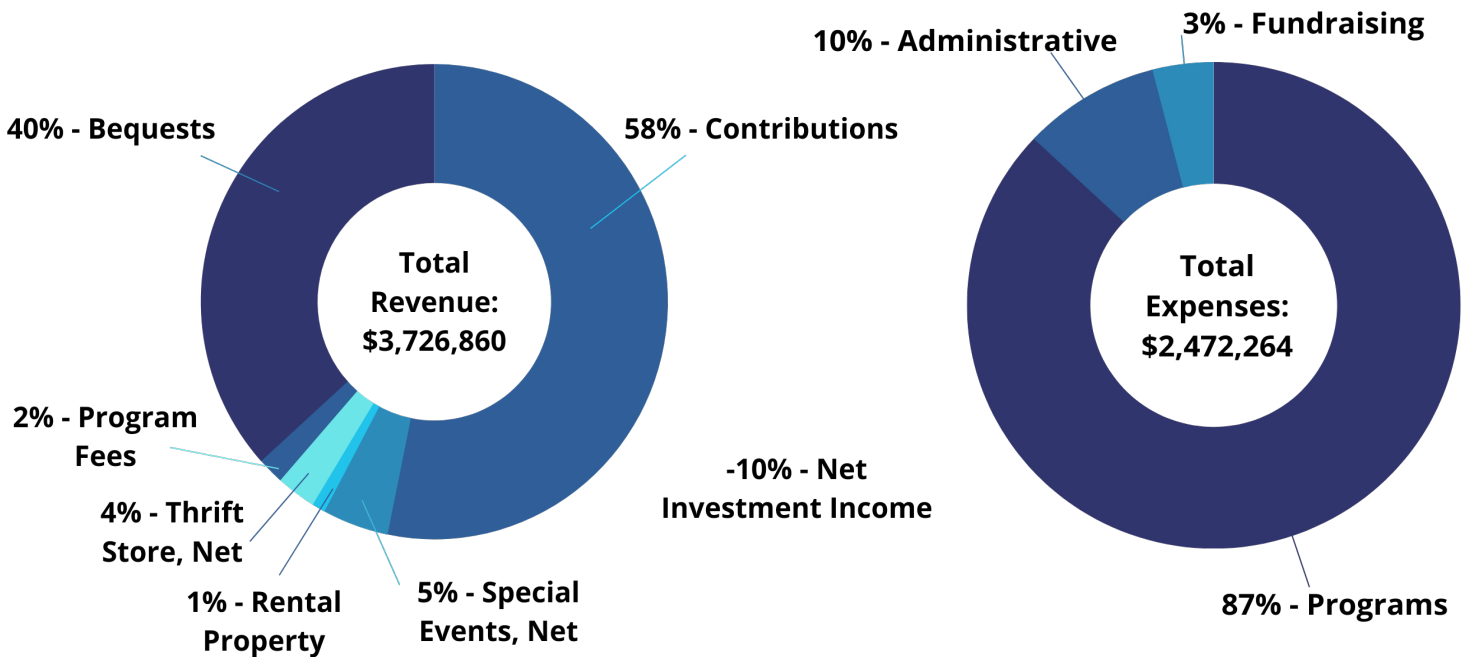

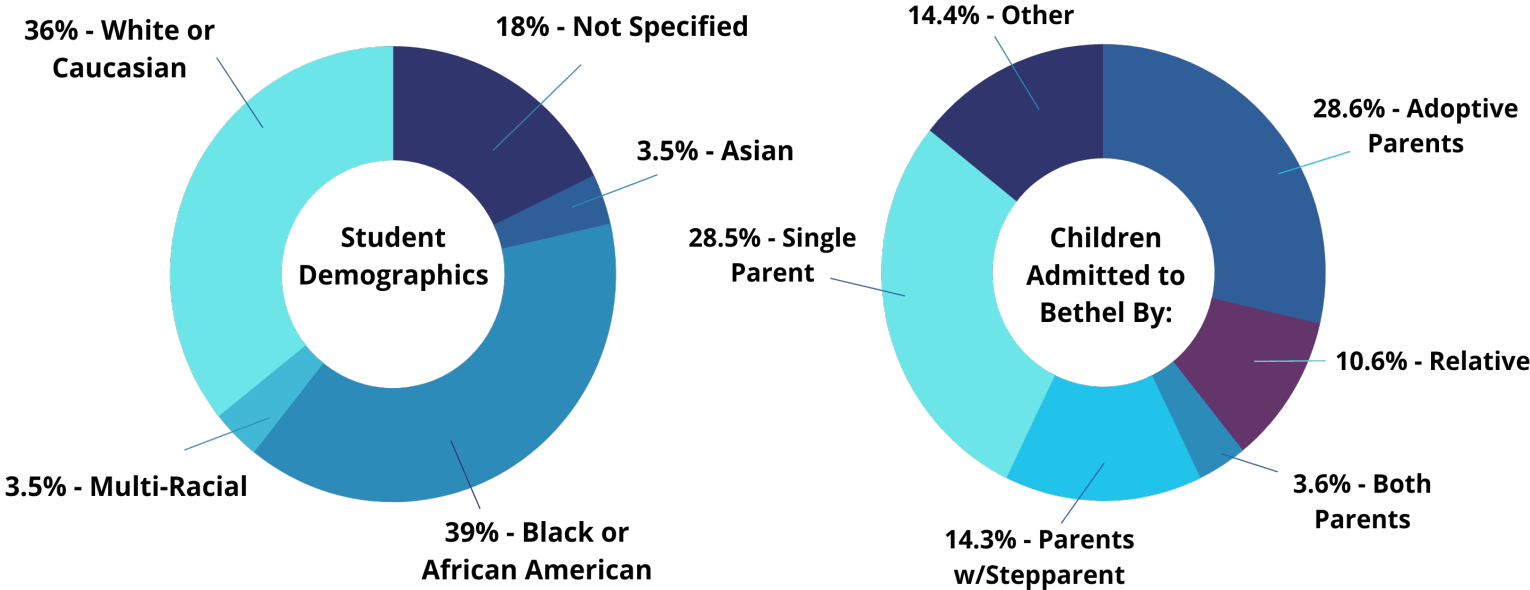
3,530 VOLUNTEER HOURS
