SUMMARY/OBJECTIVE: The position of Paraprofessional exists to assist students who are in care at Bethel who have been determined by a multidisciplinary team to need self-contained instruction based on the student's I.Q., grade level, learning disabilities, or behavior.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Exemplify a vibrant Christian faith personally and professionally. The individual fulfilling this role
 will protect the credibility of the Bethel Bible Village mission by complying with the Bethel Bible

- Assist with youth who may have academic and behavioral concerns.
- Work with students in groups and individually during lessons and create progress notes and reports.
- Work closely with the teacher in your assigned classroom and support them in their duties.
- Be flexible as your tasks may change day-to-day.
- Attending all conferences, team meetings, and training as directed by the Principal and Education Coordinator.
- Work together with the Program Services staff to accomplish the goals set for each child.

<u>Specialized Knowledge Licenses, etc.</u> State licenses and certifications to be able to teach in Tennessee are a plus.
