The teacher will design, implement, and assess curriculum that aligns with state standards, industry certifications, and workforce needs. This role advances community partnerships to support curriculum development, program instruction, hands-on training, onsite career exploration, and potential employment opportunities.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Develop and deliver rigorous and engaging instruction in the Career Readiness program.
- Prepare lesson plans that integrate academic competencies, technical training, and workplace readiness skills.
- Utilize a variety of instructional strategies, including hands-on labs, simulations, projects, and technologyenhanced learning.
- Monitor and evaluate student performance through formative and summative assessments; provide constructive feedback and targeted support.
- Maintain accurate and timely records of grades, attendance, and student progress.
- Support student attainment of industry-recognized credentials, certifications, and/or dual credit opportunities where applicable.
- Ensure classroom and laboratory environments are safe, organized, and compliant with all regulations and school policies.
- Collaborate with colleagues, administrators, and industry partners to ensure curriculum relevance and continuous program improvement.
- Coordinate with the treatment team to ensure that goals align with treatment plan.
- Build and maintain positive relationships with students, parents, and community stakeholders to promote CTE initiatives.
- Participate in professional development and stay current with instructional practices, emerging technologies, and industry trends

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

<u>Spiritual</u>: Be an active, participating member in a local Christian church. In accordance with the Mission of Bethel Bible Village, we will share the gospel with children in our care, as well as their families, to help them know and respond to the love of God in Christ.

<u>Education/Experience</u>: Bachelor's degree in Education or related CTE field preferred. Relevant instruction experience in academic setting and/or professional certification are required. Background in trauma informed education and teaching nontraditional learners.

<u>Specific Skills/Requirements</u>: Demonstrated knowledge of instructional strategies, classroom management, and student engagement practices. Strong organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills. Commitment to equity, access, and preparing all students for postsecondary and workforce success.

<u>Specialized Knowledge, Licenses, other</u>: Valid state teaching certification and/or licensure in various CTE program areas, or the ability to obtain appropriate certification.
